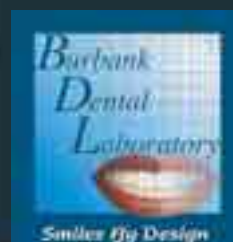

Dr. Christensen is a Prosthodontist and the Director of Practical Clinical Courses (PCC) in Provo, Utah.
